TONIGHT, YOU ARE THE AUDIENCE OF A MYTHICAL RADIO STATION, KSUN. WE HOPE YOU WILL THOROUGHLY ENJOY THE EXPERIENCE, AS WE DO IN BRINGING IT TO YOU.

RADIO WAS AN IMPORTANT PART OF FAMILY LIFE IN THE FIRST HALF OF THE CENTURY. IT WAS A TOOL USED TO INFORM THE PUBLIC OF CURRENT NEWS WITH A DRAMATIC FLARE. IT ALSO BROUGHT EXCITING ENTERTAINMENT INTO EVERY HOME. DURING THE "DEPRESSION ERA" MANY GREW UP WITH THE PHENOMENON KNOWN AS RADIO BEING THE ONLY FORM OF ENTERTAINMENT.

FOR THOSE LISTENERS. WHO CAN FORGET THE CHARACTERS OF SUCH DRAMATIC MYSTERY FAVORITES AS "THE SHADOW", "INNER SANCTUM" (WITH ITS HAUNTING SQUEAKING DOOR), "THE WHISTLER" (WITH ITS EERIE WHISTLING INTRODUCTION). "THE GREEN HORNET", "BOSTON BLACKIE" AND "I LOVE A MYSTERY" WERE ALSO FAVORITE THRILLERS.

WESTERN FANS TUNED IN WEEKLY FOR A REAL LIVE FOLK HERO - TOM MIX, AND TO THE EPISODES OF "RED RIDER" AND HIS PARTNER "LITTLE BEAVER" "THE LONE RANGER AND TONTO". PERHAPS SOME OF TONIGHT'S SOUND EFFECTS WILL HELP YOU RECAPTURE A LITTLE OF THOSE MEMORIES. AMONG THE EVENING OFFERINGS WAS THE "LUX THEATER" WHICH PROVIDED ENJOYABLE DRAMA FOR THE ENTIRE FAMILY. THERE WAS THE "FIRESTONE HOUR" WITH CLASSICAL MUSICAL ENTERTAINMENT; THE FRED ALLEN AND JACK BENNY COMEDY SHOWS BOTH HAD TALENTED WRITERS WHO MANAGED TO GET YOUR SIDES SPLITTING FROM LAUGHTER. THE 9 O'CLOCK SPECIAL WAS "AMOS AND ANDY". WHEN THIS HOUR ARRIVED, THE CHILDREN'S GAMES OF HIDE AND SEEK OR RUN SHEEP RUN WERE PLACED ON HOLD IN ORDER FOR EVERYONE IN THE FAMILY TO GATHER AROUND THE RADIO.

ONE OF RADIO'S MOST FAMOUS MUSICAL SHOWS WAS THE LUCKY STRIKE HIT PARADE, A WEEKLY PROGRAM CREATED TO IDENTIFY THE TOP TUNE IN THE NATION FOR THAT WEEK. OF COURSE, AN EXTRA TUNE WAS THROWN IN OCCASIONALLY TO FILL A TIME SLOT, CALLED THE LUCKY STRIKE EXTRA. MANY OF YOU PROBABLY KEPT PACE WITH THE FAVORITE TUNES THROUGH THIS PROGRAM.

EACH PROGRAM HAD ONE OR MORE COMMERCIAL SPONSORS AND MANY OF THESE PROGRAMS AND SPONSORS HAVE BEEN ASSOCIATED TOGETHER EVER SINCE. DO YOU REMEMBER, JOHNSON'S GLO COAT WAX WAS SPONSOR OF "FIBBER MCGEE AND MOLLY". RALSTON CEREAL FOR "TOM MIX" AND OF COURSE WHEATIES SPONSORED "JACK ARMSTRONG THE ALL AMERICAN BOY." WHO COULD FORGET THE MOST FAMOUS SPONSOR CALLS OF ALL TIME "CALL FOR PHILLIP MORRIS." AS PART OF TONIGHT'S SHOW, YOU MAY HEAR A FEW OF THESE OLD COMMERCIAL CHESTNUTS.

TODAY, RADIO IS VERY MUCH ALIVE AND KICKING. HOWEVER, IN PRIME TIME, IT IS OVERSHADOWED BY TELEVISION. THE RADIO, WHICH CREATED A "THEATER OF THE MIND" HAS GIVEN WAY TO TV'S EXPLICIT PICTURES AND VERY LITTLE IS LEFT TO THE IMAGINATION.

OUR KSUN STANDS FOR THE VOICE OF THE "VALLEY OF THE SUN", AND SO NOW, PLEASE COME BACK WITH US TO THOSE DAYS OF YESTERYEAR WHEN RADIO WAS KING OF THE AIRWAVES.

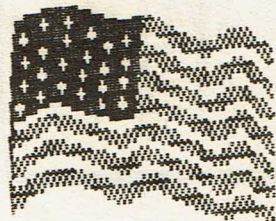

REMEMBER WHEN

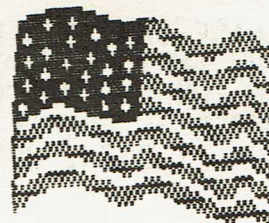
A BARBERSHOP QUARTET

REMEMBER WHEN BEGAN SINGING BARBERSHOP HARMONY IN PHOENIX, ARIZONA IN 1979. IN 1980 REMEMBER WHEN QUALIFIED TO ENTER COMPETITION ON THE INTERNATIONAL LEVEL, WHICH WAS HELD IN SALT LAKE CITY. THEY PLACED 11TH IN THE NATION AND WENT ON LATER, IN OCTOBER, TO WIN THE FAR WESTERN DISTRICT QUARTET CHAMPIONSHIP. BY JULY OF 1990, REMEMBER WHEN HAD COMPETED ON THE INTERNATIONAL STAGE ELEVEN TIMES WITHOUT A PERSONAL CHANGE. THEY PRESENTLY RANK 10TH IN THE WORLD. THE QUARTET HAS PERFORMED FOR THE MAYOR OF PHOENIX, THE GOVERNOR OF ARIZONA AND THE VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, NOW PRESIDENT, GEORGE BUSH.

THE QUARTET IS COMPOSED OF LEAD-SINGER (NEW ADDITION TO THE QUARTET) TED BRADSHAW AND TENOR AL MAU, BOTH INTERNATIONAL CHAMPIONS PREVIOUSLY WITH THE WESTERN CONTINENTALS. TED ALSO SANG LEAD WITH THE FINALIST QUARTET COMMAND PERFORMANCE IN THE MID 70'S. HE BRINGS NOT ONLY VALUABLE EXPERIENCE TO THE QUARTET BUT EXTRAORDINARY TALENT. AL MAU, SUPER TENOR FROM OUT OF THE PAST, SANG NOT ONLY WITH THE WESTERN CONTINENTALS BUT PERFORMED MANY TIMES ON THE INTERNATIONAL STAGE WITH THE PACIFICAIRE. HE IS A JUDGE IN THE SOUND CATEGORY IN THE FAR WESTERN DISTRICT. BASS-SINGER RICK WELLS, KNOWN PRIMARILY FOR HIS MODESTY, BEGAN QUARTETING IN 1973 AND HAS BEEN EXPERIMENTING WITH THE PHENOMENON EVER SINCE. HIS OUTSTANDING BASS QUALITY ADDS A GREAT DEAL TO THE QUARTET'S SOUND AND OVER ALL PERFORMANCE. GALEN McCLAIN SINGS BARITONE AND OTHER ILLEGAL PARTS. HE SANG WITH TED IN THE COMMAND PERFORMANCE. TED IS A DATA PROCESSING MANAGER (RET.) AL IS A FINANCE MANAGER (RET.), RICK IS AN ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR, AND GALEN IS AN ENGLISH TEACHER (RET.). THE QUARTET ARE ALL MEMBERS OF THE PHABULOUS PHOENICIANS CHORUS OF PHOENIX.
